Dear Ezras Israel members and supporters:

We hope that this letter finds you and your families well and safe. We will be having our High Holiday Services at our shul this year as we could not meet the Ring House pandemic related health screening and badging processes they require of all visitors. Whether you joined us last year or not, we hope you can participate this year with your presence and your financial support.

Like last year, our High Holiday services will take place in our shul rather than the Ring House as their management is rightly and primarily concerned with health and safety of their residents and are not yet willing to allow outsiders to congregate on their premises without a temperature check, and using their electronic health screening and badging. While we are able to comply with this for our daily minyan that restarted at the Ring House on May 1, 2022, complying with these processes on Yom Tov without compromising halachic restriction is not possible. This year we will again conduct services in our recently renovated Shul at 803 Montrose Road with an open and modern well-ventilated space. As was done last year, we will have expanded seating downstairs in our basement and in a covered area in the rear patio area for those who prefer to sit outside. While Halachically it is preferable to have all Minyan attendees in one room, under the guidance of Rabbi Kreiser our arrangement would be Halachically acceptable during these times. The services will once again be abbreviated, as determined by Rabbi Kreiser.

We invite you to attend by returning the attached holiday reservation form explicitly selecting your seating preference; inside or outside on the covered patio. Attendees have the option to wear masks, and we request that attendees keep at least one seat separation for social distancing from other attendees who are not living in the same residence, if requested. Should we have more demand than capacity, we apologize, but we will need to give priority to dues paying members of the congregation.

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide organized childcare again this year.

Our shul, like most, is sustained by the contributions of its members and supporters. We therefore turn to the community to help us continue to serve you. An important source of revenue for the shul is the payment for seats and related services for the High Holidays. Please see the following pages for suggested ways you can participate in that support. Our shul welcomes every individual, regardless of their ability to contribute financially. If finances are a challenge for you at this time, please feel free to contact Rachmil Jacobovits, High Holiday Committee chairman, at 301-461-4984, and be assured that a suitable arrangement will be worked out in a confidential and dignified manner.

We ask for the assistance of all our members and supporters who can help sustain our Synagogue during this difficult period. Although we believe it is safe for everyone who has been properly vaccinated and boosted to return to shul services, we do not provide individual health advice. For those who consider themselves at greater risk and are unable to attend High Holiday services, we ask that you consider a donation in the amount of a ticket, or any amount you can contribute. You can still participate in other High Holiday activities such as Machzor dedications and the newly redesigned Yizkor Memorial Book. We hope and pray that we will very soon all be able to, BE”H, participate in services and activities, together, in person, at Ezras Israel and at the Ring House.


Please take a moment to look at the enclosed forms with this letter.

4. **Kaddish Recital:** If one would like Rabbi Kreiser to recite Kaddish on a Yahrtzeit, please fill out the Hebrew date of the Yahrtzeit.
5. **Machzor (Prayer Book) Dedication:** Please use this form to dedicate one or more Rosh Hashanah or Yom Kippur machzorim (prayer books) in memory or honor of a loved one or dear friend.

Following receipt of your order and payment, we will send you an acknowledgement summarizing your order, and a detailed schedule of services. Please advise us how you wish to participate in our High Holiday program by responding no later than September 22, 2022.
